

A stroll down the narrow streets around Largo do Lilau and bargain hunting for second-hand handicrafts and antiques on Armazém Velho made up for the afternoon. At the end of the day, the host stayed at San Va Hospedaria, the worn-out hotel infamous for the movie Isabella, and read a few books written by local artists purchased from Pinto Livros in this 30's style bed.

I've been living in Macau since I was 10, but at the end of this one hour travel show, I thought I was watching a travel show about a
